- 2. Photos must be high resolution.
- 3. Participants must be from Sullivan County or those counties touching Sullivan County.

 The photos must be taken from these counties.
- 4. Walk-in Entries
 - a. You may register and pay to hold your spot, but the photo will not be accepted until February 19 March 1.
- 5. No photos will be returned.
- 6. Employees and their immediate families of UT and TSU Extension are not eligible for cash prizes, but are welcome to be considered for honorable mention.
